Vitocell 100-VH/BH series tanks offer economical and reliable DHW storage

With the Vitocell 100-VH/BH series, Viessmann adds several economy options to its line of indirect-fired domestic hot water (DHW) storage tanks. Single-coil (Vitocell 100-VH) and dual-coil (Vitocell 100-BH) tanks are available in 79 and 119 USG (300 and 450 L) sizes.

All Vitocell 100-VH/BH models feature a large heat exchanger coil reaching to the cylinder floor to maximize energy transfer, utilize full tank capacity and ensure fast recovery rates. The Vitocell 100-BH tank includes a second coil to allow integration of a solar thermal system and heating boiler for shared DHW production; solar heat is transferred through the lower coil, while the boiler provides supplementary heating through the upper coil.

An optional 220V electric heating element adds further DHW heating flexibility to Vitocell 100-VH/BH tanks, eliminating boiler run-time in the summer or providing a permanent auxiliary heat source when solar heating is in short supply.

Quality glass-enameled steel construction ensures a hygienic and safe water supply while offering lasting protection against corrosion. For additional corrosion resistance, Vitocell 100-VH/BH tanks are available with a standard 1-1/4" consumable magnesium anode or an optional 220V electronic anode for long-term, maintenance-free protection in regions with poor water quality.

Two inches of CFC-free foam insulation and a fitted nylon insulation jacket minimize standby losses and help contribute to operating cost savings of up to 50% when compared to conventional direct-fired tanks.
